Members have the right to:

A responsive and competent community association.

Expect that management committee members will seek professional advice and guidance when required.

To expect honest, fair and respectful treatment by Committee Members.

Participate in governing the community association by attending meetings, serving on committees and standing for election.

Access appropriate association records and accounts.

Prudent expenditure of subscriptions, funding and any other monies.

That Luddenden Foot Civic Institute will be maintained according to established standards.

Receive all documents that address the rules and regulations governing the community association upon becoming a member.

Members have the Responsibility to:

Read and comply with the governing documents of Luddenden Foot Community Association.

Ensure that when using the premises that anything considered onward is reported to staff, volunteers or management committee members.

Treat management committee members with honesty and respect.

Vote in elections and on other issues.

Pay association subscriptions promptly.

Provide current contact information to management committee to help ensure they receive information from the community association.

Ensure that those who use Luddenden Foot Civic Institute adhere to all rules and regulations.
